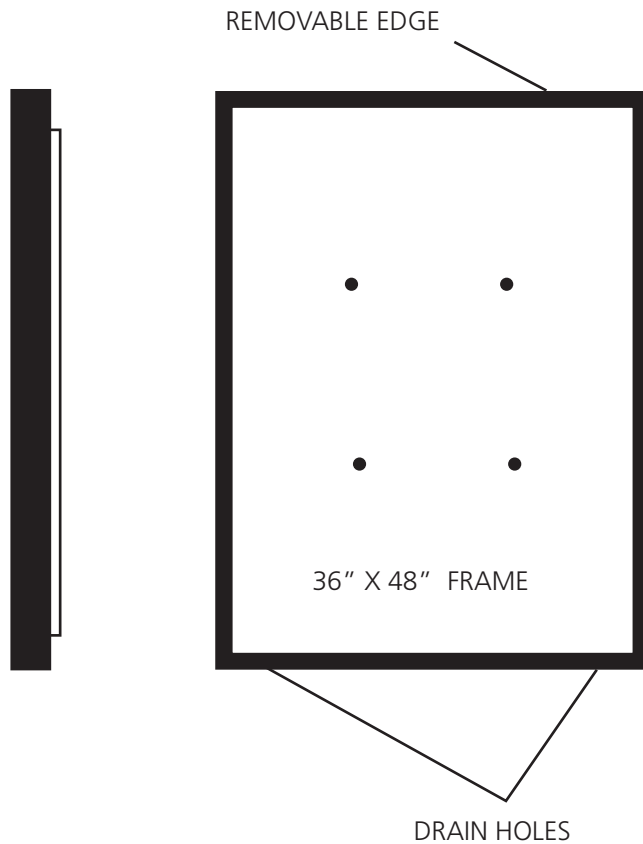

WALL-MOUNT FRAME

- Attaches to a wall or flat surface with #14 wood screws (provided).
- Attaches through back plate of frame.
- Tamper-resistant hardware with tapped holes.
- Bottom edge of frame features drain holes.
- Smaller frames have fewer mounting holes.
- Various frame sizes available in portrait or landscape orientation.
- Weatherable textured black powder coat. Other colors available

Graphic Requirements

- Graphic panels are not included with display bases.
- Frame will be sized to fit your graphic panel.
- Allow 5/8" live matter margin on all sides of artwork for frame edge.
- Maximum thickness of graphic materials is .25 inch.

WALL MOUNT FRAME INSTALLATION

The Wall Mount Frame is very similar to the Flush Mount Frame. The wood screws which are provided, go through the countersunk holes in the back plate of the frame and into your mounting surface. The frame is slightly off-set from the mounting surface to accommodate uneven surfaces and to allow the removal of one edge of the frame for installation of the sign after the frame is mounted. Any side of the frame can be the removable edge, so you may want to consider the accessibility of installing your sign when ordering your frame.

TOOLS NEEDED: hammer, level, tape measure, socket set and crescent wrench or open ended wrench set, drill and 3/8" bit, allen key set (5/32"), drop cloth or protective sheeting, circular saw for cutting wood posts.

To install, the wood screws which are provided go through the countersunk holes in the back plate of the frame, into your mounting surface.

To install your sign or graphic panel, use a 5/32" allen key remove the two bolts from the underside of the top frame edge. Slide off the top of the frame, and slide in your graphic panel. Replace the top rail and tighten the screws with your allen key.
